- **Show:** A microwave can be your handy kitchen helper. Melt or soften butter, cream cheese or chocolate without using an extra pan. Heat water or pre-cook ingredients like onions easily.

Ventilation

An over-the-range microwave includes a ventilation function which helps reduce smoke, moisture, heat, odors and grease from the kitchen, protecting kitchen surfaces.



Sensor Cooking

Microwaves with sensor cooking options make it easy to cook foods like baked potatoes, vegetables and even popcorn. Sensors evaluate the moisture levels in the microwave to help prevent overcooking.



Convection Cooking

Use your microwave as a second oven with multiple convection cycles that let you cook cinnamon rolls, cookies, pizzas and more.



Air Fry Mode

Air Fry Mode gives the flexibility of a microwave and air fryer in one appliance to free up counter space. Air fry chicken nuggets, wings, fries and more to get crispy results at home.



Easy Cleanup

Microwave models may offer steam cleaning cycles as well as special interior surfaces that wipe out easily or resist staining. A removable turntable can be quickly rinsed and replaced.
